Eligibility: This workshop is open to licensed health care professionals. These medical health professionals include Physicians, Chiropractors, Dentists,, Physician Assistants, and Nurse Practitioners, Midwives and Anesthetists. Other medical professionals include Nurses, Dieticians, Respiratory, Physical, Occupational and Speech Therapists and Child Life Specialists. Mental health professionals such as Psychologists, Counselors, Social Workers are also eligible. Students in a Masters or Doctoral program in any of those professions, are also invited to register for the workshop.

The Basic Workshop:

This 20 hour workshop will provide a framework for understanding and utilizing hypnosis in clinical practice. This is an intensive workshop which is designed to prepare clinicians to immediately begin to incorporate hypnosis into their practice. Participants should be prepared to personally experience hypnotic trance phenomenon and extensively practice trance induction in supervised small groups. Learning hypnosis requires mastery of both theoretical material and practical skills. This workshop includes 12 hours of lecture and demonstration and 8 hours of practicing hypnotic skills in small groups closely supervised by senior faculty.
