Other medical professionals include Nurses, Dietitians, Respiratory, Physical, Occupational and Speech Therapists and Child Life Specialists. Mental health professionals such as Psychologists, Counselors, Social Workers are also eligible. Students in a Masters or Doctoral program in any of those professions, are also invited to register for the workshop.

The Intermediate Workshop:

This 20 hour workshop will provide skills, strategies, and techniques for utilizing hypnosis in clinical practice for practitioners who already possess the fundamental skills of hypnosis. Skill development in hypnosis requires mastery of both theoretical material and practical skills. This workshop includes 15.5 hours of lecture and demonstration and 4.5 hours of practicing hypnotic skills in small groups closely supervised by senior faculty.
